POET OF EXILES

**Exhibition contents:**

*Artifacts:* 80+ artifacts, including photographs, letters, documents, Statue of Liberty items, sketchbooks, and sculptures.

*Films and audio recordings:* One exhibition film plus an audio program included for the installation. The film is open captioned.

*Exhibitory:* Casework, vitrines, curtains, graphics, and audiovisual equipment included.

**Additional materials:**

Press materials (including high resolution images and template of news release), and final art for a variety of collateral materials provided.

**Size:** Approximately 2000+ square feet.

**Security:** Museum security required, including surveillance while open to the public.

**Rental Fee/Booking Period:** \$27,000 for a sixteen-week block, plus the costs of design reconfiguration (as needed) and installation and de-installation costs. Borrower pays for one-way shipping of artifacts and exhibitory.

**Insurance:** To be insured by host venue

A mobile application for iPhones and Androids also available via the website.

*Emma Lazarus: Poet of Exiles* is the first major museum exhibition about the poet that wrote the famous poem for the Statue of Liberty, and includes rare artifacts that explore her unique story, message, and Jewish identity.
