“Much of the horribly painstaking thoroughness in the execution of the Final Solution—a thoroughness that usually strikes the observer as typically German, or else as characteristic of the perfect bureaucrat—can be traced to the odd notion, indeed very common in Germany, that to be law-abiding means not merely to obey the laws but to act as though one were the legislator of the laws that one obeys. Hence the conviction that nothing less than going beyond the call of duty will do.” (Arendt, Hannah. *Eichmann in Jerusalem*, pg. 137)

“The archetype for civil disobedience has claimed a constellation of first-magnitude emulators... The singular act, the risk, the dramatic appeal to a juster justice, all contribute to the high drama of the moment and the power of the actor’s role... Yet, in a curious way, to focus upon the disobedient and the process of disobedience is to accept the perspective of the established order. It is a concession that it is the man who appeals beyond law that is in need of explanation.” (Cover, Robert M. *Justice Accused: Antislavery and the Judicial Process*, pg. 1)
