Arthur Caplan, pg. 234)

“Psychologically speaking, nothing is darker or more menacing, or harder to accept, than the participation of physicians in mass murder. However technicized or commercial the modern physician may have become, he or she is still supposed to be a healer – and one responsible to a tradition of healing, which all cultures revere and depend upon.” (Lifton, Robert Jay. *Nazi Doctors: Medical Killing and the Psychology of Genocide*, pg. 3)
