

Ours to Fight For: American Jews in the Second World War

Exhibition contents:

Artifacts: 200+ artifacts, including diaries, photographs, letters, military equipment, weapons and uniforms, civilian clothing, functioning periscope, naval berths, posters, telegrams, flyers and other artifacts, graphic photo panels, and text panels.

Films and audio recordings: Seven documentary films and two audio programs produced for the exhibition and integrated into it. All films are open captioned.

Exhibitory: All walls, casework, vitrines, shelves, rails, lighting, audiovisual equipment and furniture included.

Additional materials:

Fifty copies of the school workbook *All of Ours To Fight For* will be provided free of charge, along with an electronic copy of the teacher's manual for *All of Ours To Fight For*. More workbooks can be purchased at additional cost. Press materials (including high resolution images and the template of a news release), and final art for a variety of collateral materials will be provided.

Companion volume:

Ours To Fight For: American Jewish Voices From The Second World War. A 176-page companion volume featuring 12 interviews drawn from the more than 400 recorded for the exhibit, and four short essays, including one by Tom Brokaw. Fifty copies are provided free of charge; others are available at additional cost.

Size: Approximately 2,000 square feet.

Security: Museum security required, including surveillance while open to the public.

Rental Fee/Booking Period: \$65,000 for a sixteen-week block, plus the costs of design reconfiguration (as needed), installation and de-installation. Borrower pays for roundtrip shipping of artifacts and exhibitry.

Shipping: The exhibitry requires four 20' trucks or two 48' trailers. Artifacts are crated and ship separately from the exhibitry.

Insurance: Covered by the Museum of Jewish Heritage—A Living Memorial to the Holocaust.

Website: www.ourstofightfor.org includes a short film about the exhibition, opportunities to explore artifacts and testimony and a down-loadable teacher's guide.

Ours To Fight For: American Jews in the Second World War was the grand-prize winner of the AAM Excellence in Exhibitions Competition in 2004.
