

Beyond Swastika and Jim Crow: Jewish Refugee at Black Colleges

Exhibition contents:

Artifacts: 70 + artifacts and documents.

Graphics: 20 large-scale images plus text panels, quotes and labels.

Films: Two exhibition films and made by Pacific Street films the producers of the award winning PBS film, "From Swastika to Jim Crow, which captures the voices of the scholars and their students.

Exhibitory: All casework, vitrines, audiovisual equipment and furniture included. Walls not included.

Additional materials:

Press materials (including a selection of high resolution images and the template of a news release), and final art for a variety of collateral materials will be provided. A tour outline is available.

Size: Approximately 2,000 square feet, 300 running feet.

Security: Museum security required, including surveillance while open to the public.

Rental Fee/Booking Period: \$10,000 + one-way shipping for a sixteen-week block (negotiable), plus the costs of design reconfiguration (as needed), installation and de-installation.

Insurance: To be insured by host venue
