

The Shooting of the Jews in Ukraine: Holocaust by Bullets

Exhibition contents:

Artifacts: 60+ artifacts, including rusted guns and cartridges found all over Ukraine, evidence of the massacres; propaganda posters and decrees, and personal items.

Graphics: All exhibition graphics, text and labels. A Russian translation is available as a hand-out.

Films: Fifteen video stations with testimonies of witnesses to the massacres. All films are open captioned.

Exhibitory: All casework, vitrines, audiovisual equipment and furniture included.

Additional materials:

Press materials (including high resolution images and the template of a news release), and final art for a variety of collateral materials will be provided. A Russian translation is available. An electronic copy of the tour outline is available.

Size: Approximately 2,000 square feet.

Security: Museum security required, including surveillance while open to the public.

Rental Fee/Booking Period: \$20,000 +one-way shipping for a sixteen-week block, plus the costs of design reconfiguration (as needed), installation and de-installation.
