

Project Mah Jongg

Exhibition contents:

Artifacts: 65+ artifacts, including mah Jongg sets, textiles, and mah Jongg ephemera.

Graphics: Six large graphic panels created for the exhibition by various artists, case graphics and text panels.

Audio recordings: 3 cd players and speakers with visitor activated soundscape.

Exhibitory: All casework, vitrines, audio equipment and hands-on mah jongg set for visitor games.

Additional materials:

Press materials (including a selection of high resolution images and the template of a news release), and final art for a variety of collateral materials will be provided.

Size: Approximately 900 square feet with various height interpretations.

Security: Museum security required, including surveillance while open to the public.

Rental Fee/Booking Period: \$16,000 + one-way shipping, for a twelve-week block, plus the costs of design reconfiguration (as needed), installation including installation supervisor and de-installation.

Insurance: To be insured by host venue
