Dr. Ruth Westheimer is a psychosexual therapist who helped pioneer the field of Media Psychology with her radio program “Sexually Speaking,” which began in 1980 as a 15-minute taped show that aired in New York. One year later it became a live, one-hour show on which Dr. Ruth answered call-in questions from listeners. Soon Dr. Westheimer’s expertise was distributed around the world via television, books, newspapers, games, home video, and her own website, www.drruth.com. Her books include the best-selling *Sex for Dummies: A Reference Guide for the Rest of Us*, *Dr. Ruth’s Top Ten Secrets for Great Sex: How to Enjoy it, Share it, and Love it Each and Every Time*, and *Dr. Ruth’s Sex After 50: Revving Up the Romance, Passion, and Excitement*.
